Friendly Summer Reminders

- ◆ All outdoor grills must be 10 feet away from any dwelling structure.
- ◆ Please store your lawn mower in your garage or detached storage shed after use.
- ◆ MCHA Staff will continue to do weekly yard checks throughout the summer. Please make sure your yards are mowed and properly maintained. Any yard deemed unsightly will be tagged. Please utilize the provided outdoor storage and garages to store toys and other outdoor items.
- ◆ Wading pools are allowed but MUST be emptied and stored EVERY time after use.

All residents are reminded that MCHA staff are to be treated at all times with respect. Also, when calling in emergency after hours work orders, please remember that staff have 24 hours to respond. When the on call staff person arrives, you must allow them to do their job or assess the situation until such person can repair the issue. Failure to do so will result in eviction proceedings.

Extreme Heat

Extreme heat or heat waves occur when the temperature reaches extremely high levels or when the combination of heat and humidity causes the air to become oppressive. Children, older adults, outside workers, and people with disabilities are more prone to heat exhaustion. Make sure to stay hydrated with water, stay in cool areas when possible, and wear light-weight, light colored, loose fitting clothing. During extreme heat, the temperature in your car could quickly become deadly. Please make sure to never leave children or pets in your car unattended.
