

Properly kept lawns are the responsibility of the tenants. Mowing regularly and at the proper height (3 inches) will help you maintain a healthy lawn. Please water the lawn when it browns and pull all weeds around your unit, garden, and flowers. Trim along the house and all sidewalks each time you mow. Please remember that wading pools need to be moved frequently or the lawn will turn brown. They also need to be emptied and stored after each use. **Water should not remain in the pool overnight.** Standing water is also a breeding ground for disease carrying mosquitos, such as the Zika Virus. Ensure any containers for standing water, such as old tires, pet water bowls, etc are emptied as necessary. Please supervise your children closely!
