

Changes in The Housing Choice Voucher Program Administrative Plan

Effective August 1, 2019, Menard County Housing Authority will only conduct interim re-examinations upon request for families who qualify for Earned Income Disallowance (EID) or upon request for Family Self-Sufficiency participants in order to increase their monthly escrow payment. Families may request an interim re-examination for any other reason at any time for rent increases and decreases, but are no longer required to report the change. These requests must be made in writing.

Effective August 1, 2019, participants of the Project Based Voucher Program are no longer required to participate in any supportive service sessions in order to maintain their housing assistance. These supportive services, will however, still be offered.

Effective August 1, 2019, the minimum rent for participants of the Housing Choice Voucher Program will go from \$50 to \$0.
