Important Reminders

- ⇒ Please place all outside toys in storage/garage. No outside toys should be left outside with winter approaching.
- ⇒ Yards need to be cleaned up of debris and all debris must be properly disposed of. Yard Bags are available free of charge at the MCHA office.
- ⇒ Unhook outside hoses and place in storage or garage.
- ⇒ You are only allowed to have a guest stay 14 consecutive days per year or 30 sporadic throughout the calendar year. Anything more than that has to be approved through the MCHA office or the member(s) need to be added to the lease. If this rule is not followed it is grounds for an eviction to be issued.
- ⇒ Please report bed bug sighting as soon as you see them. This is extremely important for treating and reducing the spread of an infestation.
