

COVID-19 Emergency Gap Funding

AgeLinc currently has funds available to address COVID-19 related emergency needs in the aging and disabled populations. This includes aging adults over 60, adults 55 or under with established disability, and adults 19-59 who fall under the following categories: Homebound individuals, immigrants, individuals or families experiencing homelessness or unstably housed, individuals or families not eligible for unemployment insurance, public benefits, or the federal stimulus package, individuals with disabilities, individuals with health care and mental health-related costs, individuals living in rural communities, LGBTQIA+ individuals, people experiencing wage loss, veterans, families impacted by COVID-19, and relative caregivers of minors. This funding assists with access to emergency food and supplies, interim housing and emergency shelter, health prescriptions and mental health care cost assistance, utility assistance, support for children and other vulnerable populations and more. Funding is available in Cass, Christian, Greene, Jersey, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, Menard, Montgomery, Morgan, Sangamon, and Scott counties.
